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Ceardlann na n-Óg 2025: Spórt & Cultúr

Peil Ghaelach, damhsa, scileanna iománaíochta & drámaíochta

Tá ríméad ar Ghaeilge Iorrais a fhógairt go mbeidh ócáid álainn lán-Ghaeilge ar siúl do pháistí na scoileanna Gaelachta in Iorras ar an Satharn 24 Bealtaine 2025. Reáchtálfar ‘Ceardlann na n-Óg’ sa chlubtheach, C.L.G Cill Chomáin i nGleann na Muaidhe (F26 AY20), ó 10.00rn - 2.00in ar an 24.05.2025. Comhthionscnamh é seo idir Gaeilge Iorrais, C.L.G Cill Chomáin agus an cumann iomána ‘Gaeltacht Iorrais.’

Ceardlanna difriúla a bhéas mar chuid lárnach den ócáid seo, maraon le deiseanna sóisialaithe i nGaeilge do pháistí ó scoileanna Gaeltachta Iorrais. Beidh deis ag na páistí agus iad i ngrúpaí beaga de réir aoise, páirt a ghlacadh sna ceardlanna seo a leanas; peil Ghaelach, damhsa céilí agus rince seit, scileanna iománaíochta, agus drámaíochta i nGaeilge. Gaeilge Iorrais is delighted to announce that a brand new all-Irish event will be held for children from Gaeltacht scheme schools in Erris on the 24th of May 2025. 'Ceardlann na n-Óg 2025' will be held in the Clubhouse in C.L.G Cill Chomáin, Glenamoy (F26AY20) on Saturday 24th May from 10am to 2.00pm. The event will comprise various workshops in the traditional arts and sports through the medium of Irish and an opportunity for children from Gaeltacht scheme schools in Erris to socialise together *i nGaeilge* outside school. This event is a joint initiative between Gaeilge Iorrais, C.L.G Cill Chomáin & Gaeltacht Iorrais.

Participants will be divided into small groups by age to take part in the following workshops; Gaelic football skills & games, céilí and set dancing, as well as a skills session in hurling & camogie and drama in Irish. This promises to be a fun child-centered and thoroughly enjoyable Irish language event.

This all-Irish event is designed for children from Gaeltacht scheme primary schools in this area (from 5 – 13 years of age). This event will be free but spaces are limited. You must register in advance and adhere to the Irish language policy.
